

Superintendent Report Continued:

Tom also reported that the building out by the BMX was also leveled during the storm. The wind also took the rope right off the flag on our pole. There was also a lot of debris all over the parks; especially out at Freedom Park.

Tom also advised that Frank Johnson has been in touch with him about the 2014 date for the upcoming marathon. The event is planned for late April. We have also been talking about a "fundraiser marathon" which would be held in May. Moneys raised at this event would benefit Freedom Park. Tom advised that the Disc Golf Tourney went very well with 20 to 22 participants which included 2 girls. They all seemed to enjoy the course and its challenging terrain. Tom added that in the spring of 2014 our course will be added to the disc golf circuit. There are 4 to 5 courses on the circuit including Portage, Munster Freedom Park. He is planning on introducing circuit of smaller courses throughout Lake and Porter counties for disc golf enthusiasts.

In other business, the Lions Club donated ten (10) trees which have been planted at Freedom Park. The washrooms have been closed and winterized. We did have someone from Lake County Parks come and look at the batwing that is now for sale.
