Freedom Park Board Meeting

Tuesday May 19, 2015

Meeting Start Time: 6:00p.m.

Pledge of Allegiance:

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all present.

Board Members/Public present:

Harold Mussman, LeAnn Angerman & Alice Dahl were present. Randy Hall was unable to attend. Also present, Tom Sullivan and Candy Johnson. No press members were present.

Approval of Meeting Minutes:

Harold Mussman asked for a motion to approve the April 21, 2015 minutes. Motion to approve minutes was made by Alice Dahl and seconded by LeAnn Angerman. Motion carried.

Review of Freedom Park Claims:

After review of submitted Park Claims and discussion, motion to approve was made by Alice Dahl and seconded by LeAnn Angerman, Motion carried.

Reports:

Freedom Park Updates:

Volleyball equipment has been delivered. Tom reported that he had met with Bill Marshall and the courts should be ready soon. Tom reminded that Board about the sand estimate for the courts. (\$3052.00) This amount will be deducted from Park Improvements.

The dog park agility equipment has been delivered. We have assembled the equipment and it is ready for installation out in the Dog Park.

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Mulch for the playground equipment was approved. A purchase order has been turned in. We are going to get between 14 and 18 ton of rubber mulch priced at around \$12,000.00. Discussion followed about the future of Freedom Park and our current agreement with the DNR.

In other business, Tom advised that the tree on the southeast corner of the house has been cut down. The wood is there and free for the taking if anyone would like to have it.

We are looking at hosting a disc golf tournament on August 2nd. (This is a tentative date) The agreement is that a portion of the ticket sales will go towards the ongoing development of Freedom Park.

Next Tom advised that our batwing has been sold to the Street Department for \$2,700.00.

Tom advised that the washrooms at Evergreen, Liberty and Freedom Park have been opened for public use. Three (3) toilets had to be repaired before opening them to the public.

Discussion about the walking path followed. Tom advised that Randy Hall had contacted him earlier today. Randy advised that he got a final price of \$9.35 per ton for trucking. LeAnn asked how many tons of material we had talked about. (approximately 2,200 tons) Alice asked how many ton each truckload hold. Harold Mussman advised roughly 20 tons per truck load; or approximately 110 truckloads. Discussion about our budget and available funds followed.

New Business:

LeAnn Angerman made a motion to transfer \$4,000.00 from Freedom Park Repair and Maintenance to Freedom Park Improvements. The motion was seconded by Alice Dahl. Motion carried.
