Public Comment:

Councilman Will Farrellbegg and his wife Martha were present. Will discussed the disc golf course and said that he feels that players should pay a fee to play the course. He then asked about the "recycle center" that is located at Freedom Park. Will asked if Freedom Park benefits financially from having the recycle center out at Freedom Park. Discussion followed with Alice advising that at the time the "recycle center" went in at Freedom Park, Jeff Langbehn was in charge of this project, however, he is no longer employed by Lake County Solid Waste. At that time, Mr. Langbehn agreed to the purchase of security cameras. These cameras are directed toward the recycle center. He also agreed to periodically provide benches for Freedom Park that are made from recyclable materials.
