

**REDEVELOPMENT COMMISSION MEETING  
JANUARY 26, 2015**

President Nicksch called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Members present were Doug Nicksch, Jim Langen, LeAnn Angerman, Greg Shook, and Craig Earley. Timothy Cottingham was not in attendance. Also present were Clerk-Treasurer Judith Walters, Town Council President Christopher Salatas, Building Administrator Tom Trulley, one citizen, and one member of the press.

**NEW BUSINESS**

Swearing in of members – Clerk-Treasurer Judith Walters swore in the Redevelopment Commission members.

2015 Election of Officers – Mr. Langen made a motion to nominate Doug Nicksch as President, seconded by Mr. Earley and carried by voice vote with five ayes. Mr. Earley made a motion to nominate Jim Langen as Vice-President, seconded by Mrs. Angerman and carried by voice vote with five ayes. Mr. Langen made a motion to nominate Mrs. Angerman as Secretary, seconded by Mr. Earley and carried by voice vote with five ayes.

Mr. Nicksch stated it was his understanding that the Commission, per State Statute, needed to meet by the end of January to elect officers, but was planning on sticking with the regularly scheduled meeting date of the fourth Thursday of every month at 6:00 PM. He stated between now and the next meeting, he would like the members to do some planning as to what they would like to see happen with the Commission, and that he may try to set up a meeting with the Town Council members to make sure that everyone is on the same page.

**PUBLIC COMMENT**

Clerk-Treasurer Walters explained that a student from Purdue Calumet will be starting an internship with the Town, and one of the things he will be doing is recreating the website. She stated she would like for him to come to a Redevelopment Commission meeting to get some ideas as to what the members would like to see on the website. Mr. Nicksch stated that was great and that he was also planning on reaching out to the Northwest Indiana Forum and Don Koliboski with the Lake County Economic Alliance to possibly set up another meeting.
