

**LOWELL TOWN COUNCIL
REGULAR MEETING
JUNE 8, 2015**

The regular meeting of the Lowell Town Council was called to order on Monday, June 8, 2015 at 7:00 P.M. by President Christopher Salatas. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited followed by a moment of silence. Deputy Clerk-Treasurer Gena Knapp called the roll. Members present were Craig Earley, LeAnn Angerman, Christopher Salatas, and Edgar Corns. Donald Parker was not in attendance. Also present were Town Attorney Nicole Bennett, Police Chief Erik Matson, Building Administrator Tom Trulley, one members of the media, and seven citizens.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Councilman Corns made a motion to approve the May 26, 2015 regular meeting and work session minutes, seconded by Councilwoman Angerman and carried with four ayes.

APPROVAL OF VOUCHERS

President Salatas asked for approval of White Vouchers #1522 - #1569 - \$362,882.21, White-Police #4117 - #4128 - \$2,570.44, Water #2351 - #2387 - \$107,753.77, Waste Water #3292 - #3319 - \$395,649.21, and Stormwater Utility #5073 - #5078 - \$5,131.15. Councilman Earley made a motion to approve the vouchers as listed, seconded by Councilman Corns and carried with four ayes.

MONTHLY REPORTS- May 2015

Councilman Corns made a motion to approve the May 2015 Monthly Reports, seconded by Councilman Earley and carried with four ayes.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Public Works Department Update - No report given.

Appointment to Lake County Solid Waste District - President Salatas stated he believed that Councilman Corns would be a good fit for the position. Councilwoman Angerman agreed and made a motion to appoint Councilman Corns to the Lake County Solid Waste District, seconded by Councilman Corns and carried by roll call vote with four ayes.

NEW BUSINESS

Permission to set public hearing for additional appropriation for Freedom Park - President Salatas asked if the Council needed to set the date, or if they just needed to agree to give permission for the date to be set. Attorney Bennett stated they could either give permission for the date to be set or set it themselves if they had a date in mind. Councilwoman Angerman made a motion to give permission to Clerk-Treasurer Walters to set the date for a public hearing, seconded by Councilman Earley and carried by roll call vote with four ayes.

President Salatas announced that the next regular meeting will be held Monday, June 22, 2015 at 7:00 P.M.

MEDIA QUESTIONS/PUBLIC COMMENTS

Mary Wilds, The Times, asked what the date of the public hearing would be. President Salatas stated they did not set the date yet, they just needed to give permission to Clerk-Treasurer Walters to do so. Ms. Wilds then asked what the additional appropriation for Freedom Park was for. Councilwoman Angerman stated the additional appropriation is to move \$2,700 that they received from the sale of equipment to the Freedom Park Improvement Fund. Ms. Wilds asked what the improvement would be. Councilwoman Angerman stated it would be used for walking paths.

ADJOURNMENT

Councilman Corns made a motion to adjourn at 7:06 P.M., seconded by Councilwoman Angerman and carried with four ayes.
