

**LOWELL TOWN COUNCIL
REGULAR MEETING
May 13, 2024**

The regular meeting of the Lowell Town Council was called to order on Monday, May 13, 2024, at 7:00 P.M. by Council President Todd Angerman. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited followed by a moment of silence. Clerk-Treasurer Jill Murr called the roll. Members present were Todd Angerman, Michael Gruszka John Alessia, Shane Tucker, and John Yelkich. Staff present were Town Manager Craig Hendrix, Police Chief Jim Woestman, and GIS Director Greg White. Town Attorney David Westland joined via Zoom.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Councilman Tucker made a motion to approve the April 22, 2024, Work Session and Regular meeting minutes, seconded by Councilman Alessia and carried with five ayes on voice vote.

APPROVAL OF TREASURER'S REPORT

Councilman Tucker made a motion to approve the April 2024 Treasurer's Report, seconded by Councilman Gruszka and carried with five ayes on voice vote.

APPROVAL OF VOUCHERS

President Angerman stated he reviewed the vouchers. ANNOUNCEMENTS


Councilman Angerman announced that the next regular meeting will be Tuesday, May 28, 2024. There will be two public hearings at this meeting.
