

**LOWELL TOWN COUNCIL  
REGULAR MEETING  
August 26, 2024**

The regular meeting of the Lowell Town Council was called to order on Monday, August 26, 2024, at 7:01 P.M. by Council President Todd Angerman. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited followed by a moment of silence. Clerk-Treasurer Jill Murr called the roll. Members present were Todd Angerman, Michael Gruszka, John Alessia, Shane Tucker, and John Yelkich. Staff present were Town Manager Craig Hendrix, Police Chief Jim Woestman, GIS Director Greg White; and three interested citizens.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**
