

**LOWELL TOWN COUNCIL
REGULAR MEETING
September 9, 2024**

The regular meeting of the Lowell Town Council was called to order on Monday, September 9, 2024, at 7:00 P.M. by Council President Todd Angerman. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited followed by a moment of silence. Clerk-Treasurer Jill Murr called the roll. Members present were Todd Angerman, John Alessia, Shane Tucker, and John Yelkich. Michael Gruszka was absent. Staff present were Town Manager Craig Hendrix, Police Chief Jim Woestman, GIS Director Greg White; and twenty interested citizens.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Councilman Yelkich made a motion to approve the August 26, 2024, Regular meeting minutes, seconded by Councilman Alessia and carried with four ayes on voice vote.
