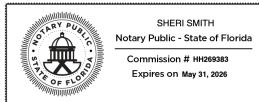

NOTICE OF PULBIC HEARING

The Town Council of the Town of Lowell, Lake County, Indiana, gives notice that it will conduct a public hearing on Monday, February 24, 2025, at 7:00 pm, or as soon thereafter as its agenda will permit, at the Town Hall, 501 E. Main Street, Lowell, Indiana 46356, on an Ordinance to amend miscellaneous sewer charges for the Town's Sewer Utility. The proposed schedule of rates and charges is set forth as follows:
Amendment of Sewer Inspections Charges and Miscellaneous Charges effective upon passage:

Inspection fee (all inspections) \$150.00;
Deposit for use of sanitary sewage system \$67.00;
Septic Waste Hauler Fees: \$191 (per 1,000 gallons pumped);
Water Service disconnection for nonpayment of utility bill \$65.00

A copy of the proposal, in the form of Ordinance No. 2025-04 is on file for examination before the hearing in the office of the Clerk-Treasurer, Town Hall, 501 E. Mani Street, Lowell, Indiana, 46356 or may be seen at www.lowell.net . Oral comments concerning the proposed ordinance will be heard at the public hearing.

Following the adoption of the Ordinance, owners of property located outside the corporate boundaries of the Town may file a written petition objecting to the rates and charges of the sewer utility in accordance with I.C. 8-1.5-3-8.1
